SECTION 00050 – INVITATION TO BID

OWNER – The OWNER of the project, Michigan City Port Authority, has contracted Edgewater Resources, LLC to be the ENGINEER for this project.

PROJECT – The work shall consist of replacing approximately 9,025 SF of timber decking on the 200 Dock and adjacent walkways at Washington Park Marina in Michigan City, Indiana.

TIME – Sealed bids will be received until 5 PM CST, October 7, 2019 in the office of Michigan City Port Authority, 200 Heisman Harbor Drive, Michigan City, IN 46360. The bids shall be publically opened at the above address.

BIDS – All bids shall be addressed to the Michigan City Port Authority, 200 Heisman Harbor Drive, Michigan City, IN 46360. Bids shall be sealed and shall have the name and address of the bidder and the contract for which the bid is being submitted on the outside of the envelope. All bidders shall bid in accordance with and upon the bid forms included in the contract documents. **All bid forms in Section 00400 shall be signed, dated and submitted with the bid submittal package, as per section 00200 of the Instructions to Bidders.**

MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING – No formal pre-bid meeting will be held for this project. Potential bidders to contact Tim Frame, Harbormaster to view the site prior to bidding at (219) 898-7260.

EXAMINATION AND/OR PROCUREMENT OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS – The contract documents are on file for inspection at the Michigan City Port Authority, 200 Heisman Harbor Drive, Michigan City, IN 46360. Copies of the contract documents may be obtained via e-mail (chassenger@edgewaterresources.com) free of charge or in hard copy format by personal pick-up at the above location for a non-refundable fee of \$25.00 for each set of contract documents.

BID SECURITY – A certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid, made payable to Michigan City Port Authority, will be required with each bid.

BID REJECTION – The OWNER reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the bid or bids, consistent with law, which best serves the interest of the OWNER.

WITHDRAWL OF BIDS – No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of forty-five (45) days after the scheduled opening without the consent of the OWNER.

AWARD OF BID – The OWNER will notify the successful bidder within forty-five (45) days after receiving bids. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory performance and labor and materials payment bond and other items as described by the contract documents.
